

Péter Pelyvás was an associate professor at the Department of English Linguistics IEAS, at the University of Debrecen until 2011. In 2015 he won the Ország László Award. His main interest lies in the interface area of syntax, semantics, and pragmatics, connected with the study of modality as expressed by the English modals and cognitive predicates. His significant contribution to the field is the reassessment and refinement of the conceptual content that goes into a modal meaning (especially in deontic modality), and a detailed analysis of how this content, while itself changing, opens the way for the metaphorical extension of these meanings into the epistemic domain.
